Libertyville Days Road Closure Information

Downtown road closures for the Libertyville Days festival will begin on Tuesday, June 15th.

The following areas will have street closures and/or restricted vehicle traffic.

- Church Street (from Milwaukee to Brainerd) /Civic Center Parking Lot:
Closed beginning Tuesday, June 16th to Monday, June 22nd.
- Cook Avenue (from Milwaukee to Chase Bank entrance):
Closed beginning Tuesday, June 16th, through Sunday, June 21st.
- Broadway (from Milwaukee to Park Place):
Closed beginning Tuesday, June 16th, through Sunday, June 21st.

The parade will begin at 10 a.m. on Saturday, June 20th, travel south along Milwaukee Avenue to Highland Middle School, and should conclude by noon. Milwaukee Avenue will be closed between Winchester and Rockland roads for the parade and patron safety, and will reopen once cleared by cleaning crews.

The Village will post information on social media and on its website to communicate that businesses remain open and that parking is available in the Lake and Church Street public parking garages. Parking information is available at www.libertyville.com/parking.
